## Psychological Testing Services

Associated Counseling Professionals has the ability to administer, score, and interpret a wide variety of tests for individuals and couples. These tests include the Alcohol Use Inventory, Minnesota Multiphasic Personality Inventory (MMPI-2), Minnesota Multiphasic Personality Inventory for Adolescents (MMPI-A), Myers-Briggs Type Indicator, Strong Interest Inventory, the SASSI-3(a substance-abuse assessment indicator) and Campbell Interest and Skills Survey. These tests are used for a variety of purposes, from evaluating an individual's skills as part of career counseling to the administration of tests for legal issues.

Dave Carver, supervising licensed clinical psychologist, has extensive training in the administration, scoring, and interpretation of all of the tests Associated Counseling Professionals provides. Dr. Carver is available to provide written interpretation and reporting for each of the tests. A comprehensive listing of the tests available, including estimated time requirements for administration, and fees, is available upon request.

## Training for Professionals
